

# PRE COLLEGE PROGRAM PRESIDENT'S FUND BURSARIES

**NEW FOR 2012 A limited number of full and partial bursaries are available to students who, for financial reasons, would not otherwise be able to attend the 2012 ACAD Pre-college Program. The bursaries will be awarded to students who can demonstrate financial need, artistic and academic ability, support from their art teacher or counselor, potential to contribute to the cultural, intellectual, artistic and overall diversity of the program, and interest and commitment to the program. A portion of the bursaries are reserved for Alberta students.**

Bursaries may be applied toward program costs only. They cannot be applied to residence accommodation or other expenses associated with the Pre-college Program. No cash will be awarded.

In order to apply, students must be 16 to 18 years of age, have completed grades 10, 11 or 12 and be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant residing within Canada a minimum of two years. Bursaries are only available to first time applicants to the ACAD Pre-college Program.

Completed ACAD President's Fund Bursary applications must be received at the ACAD Extended Studies office by 4:00pm, Friday, April 6, 2012. Without exception, incomplete or late applications will not be accepted and application packages will not be returned.

- Copy of 2010 Revenue Canada T-452 Notice of Assessment from each of your parents (if they both work outside the home) or your guardian(s)
- Copy of the official school transcript of your most recent full academic year grades
- Maximum one page statement written by you on the topic, "How I will contribute to the 2012 ACAD Pre-college Program"
- Letter of recommendation from your art teacher or school counselor
- CD, labeled with your name, containing five images of your recent art or design work in the following format:
  - jpeg file format
  - identify each jpeg with the artwork title
  - images formatted to a maximum of 1024 pixels, in either direction
  - minimum 72 dpi
  - maximum file size of 500 k
  - label your disc clearly with your name
- On a separate paper labeled with your name, list the works on the CD, stating:
  - artwork title
  - date artwork was completed
  - medium/materials used
  - size in centimeters (height, width) and depth if work is three dimensional

Check carefully that your application includes your fully completed application form and every item on the above list! Without exception, incomplete or late applications will not be accepted and application packages will not be returned.
